Meet other students from all over the world

Summer Schools are a great opportunity to enhance your knowledge and to gain exciting new experience: During our Summer School programmes you can learn German and get to know Germany's history and culture with students from all over the world.

Braunschweig is located in the northern part of Germany and was founded more than 1000 years ago. For many centuries, the city was an important trading and cultural center. Today, the region is known for its particularly high level of investment in research, but you can still stroll through medieval streets and discover the historic buildings.

Technische Universität Braunschweig looks back on a history of almost 300 years and thus has the longest tradition among universities of technology in Germany. It is part of the TU9 network, the alliance of the nine leading institutes of technology in Germany.

Our Summer Schools have a long tradition: Every year we offer 4 to 6-week intensive courses in German language and culture during the semester break. In these courses you will learn German in small groups at different language levels. During our lessons you will improve your grammar, pronunciation and vocabulary at the language levels A1 to B1/B2 (according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages). You will also learn a lot about German culture and regional studies.

Our courses are complemented by an extensive social and excursion program that allows participants to get to know TU Braunschweig and the region around Braunschweig. We visit regional companies and museums and explore various TU Braunschweig facilities. During excursions to Berlin and several German cities we get to know the history and culture in Germany better. Joint leisure activities and sufficient free time to explore on our own round off our programme.



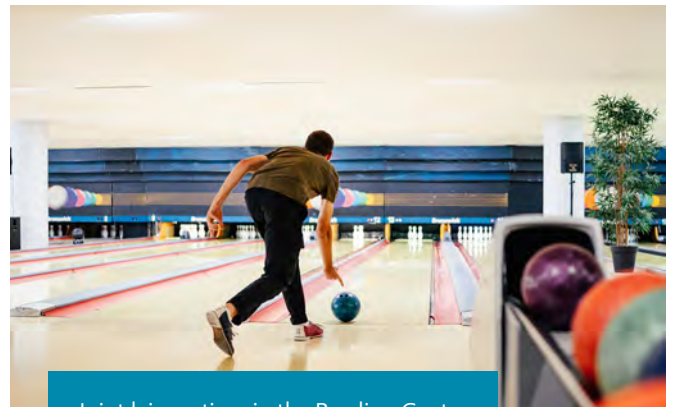

6-WEEK-COURSE

4-WEEK-COURSE

02 – 27 SEPTEMBER

This course is particularly suitable for international students who will be studying at TU Braunschweig in winter semester 2024/2025. During the Summer School you will already get to know the university campus and the city of Braunschweig. In addition, we will support you with organizational questions concerning your everyday study life, so that you can start the semester stress-free.

Scholarships and tuition waivers

If you are currently enrolled at one of our partner universities, you have the option to apply for one of our scholarships or tuition waivers.

Scholarships for our Summer School in June/July 2024:

Students from our partner universities are eligible to apply for a scholarship which covers the tuition and the teaching material as well as the costs for the social and excursion program. The application deadline is **31 March 2024**.

Tuition waivers for our Summer School in September 2024:

Students from our partner universities are eligible to apply for a tuition waiver which allows them to take part in the summer school at the cost of the teaching materials and the social and excursion programme (total of 280€). The application deadline is **15 July 2024**.
