In this course, students are introduced to the fundamentals of graph theory and learn how graphs can be used to analyze biomedical data.

Your tasks:

- Reviewing and revising exercise sheets
- Developing programming exercises
- Supporting the creation of teaching materials

We expect:

- Background knowledge in graph theory and/or data science
- Background knowledge in molecular biology is beneficial but not required
- Having attended the module before is an advantage but not required
- Knowledge of LaTeX, Git, and programming (Python/R) is advantageous
- Reliability and ability to work independently
- Good English language skills

- If interested and suitable: long-term involvement in research and teaching

The position requires 10 - 20 hours per month, depending on individual preference.
