We will examine practical scaffolding techniques, which help bridge the gap between learners' current abilities and learning objectives in a bilingual context.

In the second part, we will dive into CLIL lesson planning, a process that requires the careful integration of subject content with language goals. Participants will learn how to design lessons that enable the content-language synergy, how to choose meaningful tasks and how to select or adapt materials for the CLIL context.

The workshop will provide both theoretical insights and hands-on activities, allowing participants to leave with practical tools and strategies for planning and delivering effective CLIL lessons.
